



Arbutus Ceramic Artist in Residence Application

The Arbutus Artist in Residency (AIR) program is an unpaid volunteer exchange that offers a professional development avenue to emerging artists while providing routine maintenance for the Arbutus studios. A residency at the Arbutus Folk School is an opportunity to grow as a ceramic artist, to engage in our thriving community, and to provide a platform to launch your career.

Applicants are chosen for their ability and willingness to contribute to the growing community within the studio, the quality of their work and a perceived potential for growth. What we would like to see is a diversity of applicants who are producing quality work, are engaged in the learning community around their craft, and are passionate about craft education. We also encourage artists who pursue using their craft to advance social engagement in issues important to the community.

Submissions are due on Monday April 20th. Decisions will be made by Wednesday April 29th. The current residency will begin on May 1st 2020 and run through October 31st 2020.

Application process:

Artists must submit the following items. Please make sure your name is at the top of each document (excluding photos):

- 10 digital images of past work. Send images as separate attachments, not embedded within documents.
- C.V.
- Bio and bio photo for website
- Letter of interest which includes ceramic experience, studio experience, teaching, and any specify any experience with community engagement or work with underserved populations.
- Names and contact information of three professional references.
